HOW DOES



BUILD OUR TRUCK CAMPERS?



ALL ALUMINUM!

Tubular Aluminum forms the basis for EVERY structural component of a Soaring Eagle Camper and is WELDED together for maximum strength.

Here's a NEWS FLASH...

Your camper is going to be exposed to moisture – again and again.



The Structure of the Soaring Eagle Camper is screwed and bolted together as the camper starts to take shape.

Notice the dark colored composite board which is the backer behind both the interior wall and ceiling boards and the exterior fiberglass. This material adds R-value and is impervious to water and mold.



While some of our competitors offer what they claim is "aluminum sidewalls", they use only perimeter aluminum with hardly any wall studs in their laminated walls, claiming "the strength is in the foam". Sure it is... No studs is done to save money and supposedly weight. The thing is, aluminum is very light, so why not have more studs? The only answer is to cut corners and costs.





NO CUTTING CORNERS HERE!

Especially when it comes to the Structural Integrity of our units!

If anything, we <u>Over-Engineer</u> our Campers for Maximum Strength and Stability as they bounce down the road!



After the structure of the camper is screwed and bolted together, it is THEN **SPOT WELDED at** various points of the coach giving it a **TRUE UNI-BODY CONSTRUCTION!**

This attention to detail is unmatched in the entry level truck camper market!



STRUCTURE SCREWED & WELDED TOGETHER



Soaring Eagle Campers are also VERY WELL **INSULATED** with block foam insulation in most areas of the camper and bubble foil insulation in other areas.

Interior and exterior surfaces are backed with composite material, not wood.



Our campers earned the **GOLD STANDARD rating** from TRUMA after extensive testing in their **Arctic Chamber –** spending hours in **SUB-FREEZING** temperatures. While this test was designed to judge the efficiency of the TRUMA furnace, it proved how well insulated and sealed our campers are!
